MOYLE WINS TLR CUP TITLE

Lincoln, Mich., February 26, 2011; - Gary Moyle of Houghton, Michigan knew there would be little room for error if he wanted a chance to win the First Annual Tommy Lipar Racing (TLR) Cup Championship. Trailing Malcolm Chartier by 22 points going into the final race of the season it appeared Chartier had the title pretty well locked up, however, Moyle had other ideas as he drove his 2011 ski-doo Pro Champ to a 10 point margin of victory to claim the Championship and \$20,000, over Chartier who finished second in the standings on a Houle/ski-doo. Dustin Wahl rounded out the top three in the final standings on a Wahl/Polaris.

Overcast sky's and light snow greeted drivers at the Alcona Recreation Site for the sixth and final race of the new series founded by businessman Tommy Lipar. Despite having to deal with increased dust caused in part by falling snow, drivers had no trouble rounding the iced half-mile oval at near record speeds.

Qualifying second to fellow ski-doo ace Joel Diamond of Lapeer, Mich., for the final Moyle appeared poised and ready to give everything he had to take the race and the championship. Diamond who had yet to win a TLR Cup final had other ideas. At the drop of the green flag it appeared it would be all Moyle as he exploded off the line into the lead well ahead of Diamond in second. Finding good clean ice to run Diamond began to gain on Moyle going into the corners. Coming out of turn two going for the white flag Diamond took advantage of lap traffic and made his move to take the lead. Exiting out of turn four down the front straightaway, side by side the two nudged each other on two separate occasions before Diamond pulled out
